General Information

Attendance: Attendance will be taken by me every day during morning meeting (9:00-9:20). If your child does not attend morning meeting, they will be marked as absent. If your child has to leave early for whatever reason or is absent for the day, please email me and the main office so we can adjust their attendance in Genesis.

Virtual Learning Expectations: Children should be dressed for the day (no pajamas), breakfast already finished and at a designated remote learning work space with a fully charged chromebook at 9:00am every school day. There will be a morning message on Homebase google classroom for them to read, and they will join the google meet at 9:00am for morning meeting daily.

General Information

Remote Learning Schedule: We will be following this remote learning schedule daily.

Small Groups/Whole Groups: Children are responsible for attending all virtual meetings. This includes small groups and whole group meetings and any special area classes/G&T, band etc. Children are responsible for knowing what time their meetings are and showing up on time! **When your child is not in a small group meeting or a whole group meeting, they will have activity slides to complete either for math, reading or the afternoon.**

Groups and small group meeting schedules are subject to change, but I will keep students and families informed via google classroom and/or email

Additional Information

Instead of a Day 1-5 Rotation, we will follow a Monday-Friday schedule.

Please make sure your child has a designated work space for virtual learning. I recommend printing out their schedules so they can stay organized.

Homework

- ☐ Homework can be assigned Monday-Thursday and not over holiday breaks.
- ☐ Homework will only be assigned as necessary.
- ☐ Homework is updated on my website daily as well as updates or announcements for subsequent days. Please be sure to check my website daily for these updates.
- ☐ **Your child is responsible for completing their homework assignments independently and turning them in on time. I will only accept assignments one day late for partial credit.**

Chromebooks

- Now that we are remote, it is extremely important that your child cares for their chromebook.
 - Please make sure chromebooks are charged daily
 - Please make sure chromebooks are out of the way of spills or food
 - Please make sure chromebooks are on a solid surface and do not fall or get damaged
 - Please make sure chromebooks and chargers are not misplaced

It is expected that students are using chromebooks strictly for assignments or activities I have approved, not for leisure activities. Students should only use google hangout to chat with the teacher. Students should not create google meets or google hangouts with other students. Students should not email friends about non school related topics.

Google Classroom

Most of your child's assignments will be on Google Classroom this year.

Homebase: Google Meet link, schedules, resources, morning messages, other logistical information and announcements

Reading, Writing, Math, Science: This is where they will find their assignments for different subject areas.

Please make sure that your child is only posting in google classrooms *to the streams* if it is appropriate or approved by the teacher. [Here is a parent's guide to Google Classroom.](#)

Content Areas

Math - Monday-Friday

Reading- Monday-Friday

Social Studies (integrated with reading)

Writing- Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday

Science- Thursday and Friday

Health (alternating between science and health units)



Math Investigations

- We will be continuing using the Investigations program this year in 4th grade. Your child will complete SAB pages as they are assigned to them. **Please do not have your child go ahead and complete pages in the SAB book that are not assigned to them.**
- At the start of each unit there are family letters in the SAB books. I will post these family letters to my website for your convenience.
- Students have online access to the book and activities through Savvas Easy Bridge (they can access this through Classlink).

It is critical that your child fluently knows their multiplication facts up to 12 this year. 5 minutes a day is all it takes! I have links to websites for practice on my website and in math google classroom on my math manipulative shelf.

Reading

- We will be using the Making Meaning: Becoming a Reader program this year. This program is focused on collaboration, discussion and shares many read alouds.
- It is important that your child is reading at least 30 minutes every day to develop reading stamina.
- I have created a digital library that is posted in reading google classroom with many different read alouds for your children to listen to at their leisure.
- **Social studies will be integrated into reading and alternate some units. Social studies will have a separate category in Genesis this year.**

Writing

- We will be using the Making Meaning: Becoming a Writer program this year. This program goes hand in hand with the reading program and focuses on discussion, collaboration and the steps in the writing process.
- Writing will take place 3 days a week (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday)
- Please make sure your child has a writing notebook to jot ideas down that may not make it to google drive or google classroom.

Science/Health

- ☐ We will be working on science two days a week (Thursday and Friday)
- ☐ We will alternate units between health and science
- ☐ Students may be assigned activities to complete in their afternoon activity slides on science/health days
- ☐ Our first unit is focused on The Structure of the Earth in science.
- ☐ Our first unit is focused on Wellness in health.
