VIRTUAL EXPECTATIONS

<u>During Virtual meetings, students are expected to:</u>

- Be on time. School starts at 9 am. Have students log into the meeting from the link in the Google Classroom homepage.
- Students are to enter into meetings with their camera on and their mic muted. Students will unmute mics only when asked.
- Be attentive. No snacking or drinking unless we are on a break and I give permission.
- Come to virtual school as if it were in person. No pajamas. Eat breakfast before school starts!
- Sit in a quiet area (a desk or table). Have supplies ready and on hand.

REMOTE LEARNING INFORMATION

MORNING MEETINGS and CLOSING CIRCLE are mandatory- students should be logging on to these meetings at 9 am and 12:40 pm. The link for our meetings is in our Google Classroom homepage.

- GOOGLE CLASSROOM is where we post announcements and assignments. Announcements are posted in the section called "Stream." Assignments are posted in "Classwork" with the due date and time.
- ASSIGNMENTS for the most part will be due the same day it is assigned by 6PM, unless otherwise noted. This gives me time to review/grade their work and prevents your child from staying up late doing their work.
- PARENTS & GOOGLE CLASSROOM: Most parents are labeled as "guardians" on google classroom and thus should be getting email summaries of any missing work from their classes. This DOES NOT give you access to see all of their work, announcements, and classes- it just shows you if they are missing work or not. In order to see your child's assignments you need to have them log onto their google classroom and show you. If you are not signed up, let us know and we will add you!


